

Nottingham Nomads Early Summer Open 2025

DATE	Saturday 14th June and Sunday 15th June 2025
VENUE	Haywood Road Community Centre, 46 Haywood Road, Mapperley, Nottingham NG3 6AB. The venue itself is accessible to wheelchair users but note that only unallocated on-street parking is available.
TIMETABLE	For both days registration is from 10:25 to 10:55 for a first game starting promptly at 11:00; prizegiving and leaving venue approximately 19:00. Entry is to either or both tourneys. Please state your option when applying (see below).
COST	ABSP and organizing club members £20 per day; non ABSP members £22 per day.
REFRESHMENTS	Tea, coffee and biscuits are available between games and there is a meal break from 13:45 to 14:30. Please bring a packed meal but various shops and eateries are nearby.
FORMAT	Each day there will be a single open division (limited to 24 players) playing seven games of ABSP rated matchplay Scrabble, based on a win and spread format.
TIMERS	Clocks will be used, set to 25 minutes per player per game.
CHALLENGES	Five point penalty per word
PRIZES	Cash prizes for the top three finishers plus a ratings prize
PAYMENT	Entry fees will be collected on the day of the event. Cash preferred but bank transfer is also possible. No cheques, please!
